- I. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.
  
- II. Roll Call: Present were Steve Jungermann, Pete Heinz, Doug Marecek, Denny Lee, Theresa Sperling, Todd Hoppenstedt, Dan Meyers, Armando Sanders, Stan Bond and guests.
  
- III. Theresa Sperling moved to approve the Minutes of February 22, 2016, seconded by Doug Marecek. Motion carried 5-0.
  
- IV. Items for Discussion
  - A. Cruise Nights in Downtown Montgomery—Debbie Buchanan reported that Mr. Nocher has agreed to change the cruise nights to the last Wednesday of each month. He has worked with the VFW and got approval to use their parking lot for the event. It was also relayed to him that he cannot have food trucks, and he is working with either the VFW or South Moon to provide food.
  
  - B. West Side Event (Date, location, theme, cost, etc.)—The committee chose Sunday, June 26<sup>th</sup> as the date for the new event. It will be 4-8pm, with a band from 5-8pm. The Fox Valley Park District will provide use of the sound stage for free, and will also provide bags, hula hoops and a parachute for the kids. The Board decided to rent two portalets and approved a budget of approx. \$1,000.
  
  - C. Montgomery Fest
    - 1. Grand Marshal—Ron Keck will not be available this summer, so Denny has asked Staffords to be Grand Marshal. We are waiting for their response.
    - 2. Fencing—The committee discussed three options for fencing and selected option #1, to just fence in the carnival area. This will achieve the primary goal of controlling access to the carnival area and will also cost \$1,100 instead of \$1,950. It is possible that the township could loan us snow fencing. The State's Attorney will provide wording for signs regarding searching of backpacks. The carnival will have three ticket booths near the entrances, and the committee discussed the possibility of requiring people to purchase tickets in order to enter the carnival area. The beer tent was also discussed briefly, as new information was obtained that no fence is required by state law for a beer area.

However, permission from the Park District is needed and also a temporary liquor license. No beer will be allowed in the carnival area.

3. Report on Areas of Responsibility—The letters have been sent out to the craft vendors from the past two years.
