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Minutes

Intergovernmental Committee Meeting

- I. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.
- II. Present were Trustees Pete Heinz, Denny Lee, Steve Jungermann, Stan Bond, Theresa Sperling, Doug Marecek, Engineer Pete Wallers, Chief Dan Meyers, Director of Public Works Todd Hoppenstedt, Executive Assistant Debbie Buchanan and members of the press.

III. Approval of Minutes

- A. Doug Marecek moved to approve the Minutes of June 13, 2016, seconded by Stan Bond. Motion carried 6-0.

IV. Items for Discussion

A. TV Recycling Event

Debbie Buchanan reported that she has scheduled a one-time TV recycling event for Saturday, August 27th to take old CRT TVs. This event will have a fee of \$35 per TV over 25" and \$25 for smaller TVs. The same fees apply to computer monitors. Kane County has canceled their recycling program and there are no remaining free options to dispose of old TVs. They intend to start a new program with a recycling location in Aurora; however, there will be a fee for municipalities who participate (ours would be approximately \$2,000 per year) plus they will still be charging the same fees per TV. In addition, their site will only be open on weekdays which isn't convenient for some people. This event in August will give us an idea if we can satisfy the needs of our residents by offering an event once or twice a year.

Various payment and parking options were discussed. It was agreed to emphasize paying in advance online in order to reduce wait times. Chief Meyers will call the recycling company to discuss the layout and finalize details. He would prefer to have a separate line for the pre-paid people.

B. Montgomery Fest

It was decided to eliminate the north gate in the fence and only have one at Taylor Street and one on the path along the river. Denny Lee reported that the

Fox Valley Park District will provide officers to assist with monitoring entrance into the carnival area.

Food vendors will start setting up Thursday evening. All vendors have committed except Bojo's and Doug will call them. Pete Wallers will provide the hours for the beer tent.

Golf carts were discussed. Theresa said she needs two carts on Thursday for the craft vendors. She plans to have about 1/3 of the vendors set up on Thursday. She will also need 2-3 carts on Friday during set up and will need 3 carts on Sunday during take-down. Todd reported that he visited Kart Werks and that the owner Bob is not sure whether he is donating cart again this year or if he will charge us. Chief Meyers will discuss with him also. We still need a second driver for the people mover. Todd said Public Works will provide ramps on the curbs and will mark the locations so drivers can see them easily.
