- I. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.
- II. **Roll Call:** Present were Trustees Pete Heinz, Doug Marecek, Steve Jungermann, Denny Lee, Theresa Sperling, Village Clerk Penny FitzPatrick, Todd Hoppenstedt, Pete Wallers, Armando Sanders and guests. Chief Dan Meyers arrived at 6:03 pm and Trustee Stan Bond arrived at 6:15 pm.
- III. **Approval of Minutes:** It was moved by Trustee Sperling and seconded by Trustee Marecek to approve the minutes of January 23, 2017. Motion carried 5-0.
- IV. **Items for Discussion**
- A. Sunday in the Park – Sunday, June 25
1. Hacky Sack Guy—After discussion, it was agreed to hire this guy to do demonstrations and teach kids how to play hacky sack from 4-6pm at a cost of \$150. The park district will provide free hacky sacks.
  2. Park District Contributions—In addition to the hacky sacks, they will provide portalets, the sound stage and games.
  3. Food Vendors—The number and location of food vendors was discussed. The committee would like tacos, hot dogs and ice cream again this year.
  4. Free Ice Cream—EEL has generously agreed to sponsor the free ice cream again this year. We will need volunteers to help scoop from 4-5pm.
  5. Kendall County Mounted Rangers—Chief Meyers has requested their participation but they won't know their schedules until mid-May.
- Other items: Doug Marecek has arranged for us to use the school as an emergency shelter that day. Also, the committee approved hiring the band Redhorse at a cost of \$500.
- A. Montgomery Fest
1. Grand Marshal—Denny is working on this and hopes to have an answer by next month.
  2. Golf Carts—Todd has arranged for golf carts that will include two 6-passenger and three 4-passenger carts for \$1700. Debbie said FVPD has agreed to let us borrow 3 carts this year. Public Works will check to see if the Oswegoland Park District will do the same.

3. BMX Stunt Team—The Committee agreed to have Debbie check with the stunt team in Plano to see if they would be interested in performing this year.
4. Fireworks—Denny said the fireworks company can do a show for \$10,000 that would last at least 30 minutes. He is still working on that.
5. Special Needs—It was discussed that the River Fest and some other festivals do a special night, either free or without lights and sound, for special needs children. Some ideas were discussed and it was agreed we could possibly do this from 5-7pm on Friday, but needs further discussion.
6. Heartland Blood Drive—They have a 40' mobile unit and would like to park on Mill Street and do a blood drive during the fest. The committee agreed with this request.
7. Vendor Booths—Trustee Sperling is handling the booths again this year.
8. Helicopter Rides—Denny Lee said a company approached him who would like to offer helicopter rides at the fest. Everyone agreed not to allow this.
9. Entertainment—Debbie told the group that Legacy Girls is no longer performing together; however, the founder does shows with a male performer for \$550 for one hour or \$750 for 1.5 hours. Everyone agreed that was too expensive. Instead Trustee Bond and Sperling are going to work together to fill that time slot with volunteers, perhaps former talent show participants.
10. Drone photography—Trustee Bond mentioned that perhaps someone would like to do drone photography and video the fest as an in-kind sponsor.
