Intergovernmental Committee Meeting

- I. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m.
- II. **Roll Call:** Present were Penny FitzPatrick, Denny Lee, Pete Heinz, Pete Wallers, Dan Meyers, Armando Sanders, Steve Jungermann, Mark Wolf, Debbie Buchanan. Doug Marecek arrived at 6:25 p.m.
- III. **Minutes:** Doug Marecek moved to approve the minutes of March 26, 2018, seconded by Steve Jungermann. Motion carried 4-0.
- IV. **Items for Discussion**
 - A. Recycling Event Update—Mark Wolf provided an update on the April 21st recycling event. They had about 100 cars and only turned away 6 due to not living in Montgomery or not being eligible for the event.
 - B. Concerts in the Park (*Attachment*)—Debbie Buchanan briefly reviewed the schedule for Concerts in the Park. The park district is changing these to Wednesdays from 7-8:30. We will be providing free ice cream sundaes on June 6th.
 - B. Sunday in the Park Update—Doug Marecek provided an update. Ozinga will be bringing cement truck, Kendall County mounted police and SWAT are confirmed. Food vendors will be taco vendor from last year and Grumpy Gaucho, also the ice cream vendor will be back this year. The hot dog vendor has not responded to our emails.
 - C. Montgomery Fest
 1. Bands and Other Entertainment—The entertainment schedule was reviewed. There is still an opening for a band from 2-4pm on Saturday and several possibilities were reviewed. The group selected Blind Reflexx as first choice, with Rack and the Riddler as second choice. Debbie will contact Blind Reflexx to try to book them.
 2. Sponsorships—Doug reported that Walmart and Ozinga have both committed to \$2,500 sponsorships and VVF Dental is a \$500 sponsor.
 3. Carp Derby—The scouts will be running a scout carp derby at the same time that won't affect the regular carp derby.

4. Committee Updates—Food vendor applications and car show flyers will be mailed out soon. The first sponsorship mailing already went out. Denny Lee talked to the carnival to clarify rules for the carnivals food vendors. They must either be inside the carnival fencing or pay the standard food vendor fee. She will let the food vendors know. The beer both was also discussed and it was decided to handle them the same as the other food vendors as far as fees, etc.
5. BMX Stunt Show—We have not had a response from them yet.
6. Handicap & Parade Parking—Lyon Metal parking lot is confirmed. We will have to investigate who currently owns Mill Tavern and see if we can use that lot again this year.
7. Grand Marshal- Denny will talk to the Grand Marshal and confirm him.
8. Austin Park Portalets—Denny Lee talked to FVPD and they will provide portalets at Austin Park during the fest. He also said to be sure there are 2 portalets inside the carnival area, one handicap and one regular.
9. Mark Wolf will handle set up of the review stand. The PD will use cadets to help with parking.
