Chief of Police Daniel Meyers grew up in Aurora Illinois. He graduated from Aurora Central Catholic, Waubonsee Community College and Aurora University, with a B.A. degree in Criminal Justice. He is a 2008 graduate of the FBI National Academy Class 235. He joined the Montgomery Police Department in February of 1985. He served as a Patrol Officer, Sergeant, Detective Sergeant, Deputy Chief, and was appointed Chief of Police in November of 2010. He has built a strong reputation in over his 32 years in law enforcement for working with citizens, neighborhood leaders, and business owners to solve crime problems and improve the community. His dedication to the community reaches far beyond his role within the Montgomery Police Department.

He currently serves and is a member of several boards and committees which tie law enforcement to the community. He is also a member of several law enforcement associations, FBI National Academy Associates, International and Illinois Chiefs of Police, Kane and Kendall County Chiefs of Police Associations. Chief Meyers currently serves on the Kane County Child Advocacy Board, Kane County DUI Task Force, KenCom 911 Operations Board Co-Chairman, West Aurora School District 129 Emergency Management Team and Waubonsee Community College Criminal Justice Advisory Board. He is also past President of the Kane County Chiefs of Police Association.
