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**Minutes**

Intergovernmental Committee Meeting

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- I. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm.
- II. **Roll Call:** Present were Denny Lee, Tom Betsinger, Steve Jungermann, Dan Gier, Phil Smith, Corinne Vargas, Pete Wallers, Rich Young, Jeff Zoepfel, Penny FitzPatrick, Mark Wolf, Debbie Buchanan and guests. Matt Brolley arrived at 6:04 pm.
- III. **Minutes of September 23, 2019** Steve Jungermann moved to approve the minutes of September 23, 2019, seconded by Denny Lee. Motion carried 4-0.
- IV. **Items for Discussion**
  - A. Tree Lighting—Corinne shared some ideas for the Tree Lighting event. Games and crafts will take place inside, along with the musical groups. The Ozinga Merry Mixer will be there outside. Corinne and Debbie will be meeting with the Chamber tomorrow to finalize plans. The logistics of how to rotate singing groups inside was discussed. Moving the event inside takes the weather variable out of it, but we need to determine how to fit so many people inside.
  - B. Senior Lunch Program—Dan Gier stated that historically there has been a senior lunch at the Village Hall each month, with a program at 10am and then lunch and Bingo at 11am. The cost is \$5 and food is purchased from Riverview Diner. Currently there is one volunteer helper who helps set up and clean up, and staff members order and pick up the food, set up the room, and help with serving and clean up. An option was discussed with the seniors to move the event to the Fox Valley Park District, but the seniors were not in favor of this. Dan said another option is to move the lunch to Riverview's banquet room, where lunch would be served buffet style. There would be more space, no need for staff to set up the room, pick up food, help serve or clean up. If we do this the 10am program would be eliminated. Dan was asked to provide cost comparisons between the current program and moving it to Riverview.
  - C. 2020 Montgomery Fest Planning
    - I. Bands and Other Entertainment—Bands were discussed, and the committee agreed they want Semple and LAVA Rock together on Saturday. The goal is to have bands on stage the entire day, with only 30 minutes between bands.

More/better bands would make it a better fest but will cost more. Matt requested that Corinne schedule an Intergovernmental Meeting to review potential bands (before the Nov. 12<sup>th</sup> meeting) and report back at the November 12<sup>th</sup> Intergovernmental Meeting. Denny said to be sure and schedule a country band.

2. Stage—Corinne shared that the FVPD Soundstage will no longer be available after this year. Purchasing a stage costs approximately \$110,000, but one can be rented for approximately \$4,000. Stage vendors can also provide banners and lighting.

3. New Ideas—Some ideas were briefly discussed such as a sponsor/business kick-off event, additional food vendors, and additional VOM banners on the stage and at the entrance.
