

Driveway Permit Requirements

Submit all application materials to: permits@montgomeryil.org

Complete ALL the yellow highlighted sections of the building permit application and submit with the following:

In description, include the proposed dimensions and material (asphalt, concrete, or paver). Please state if widening driveway/apron or replacing existing.

Construction Value- the total cost of the project

Contractor Listed (Company name -or- put "Home Owner" if doing yourself)


Plat of Survey/As Built drawing with driveway dimensions marked (looks like a map of your property, you got this at closing when you purchased the home.)

Contact your HOA (if applicable)

Please note: We cannot process an application without the above information and the Julie dig number (DO NOT LEAVE BLANK). Please work with your contractor to obtain this number before applying.

General Requirements for all Driveways

- Size limits- (See Graphic) May be up to 25' wide, or as wide as the garage, and extend (at that dimension) 20' out, before tapering to a maximum of 25' width to the sidewalk.
- Cannot be in any easement.
- Must be located a minimum of 1' away from side property lines (if no easement is present).



• Must be constructed with impervious surface (no gravel)

Concrete Driveway/Apron: Minimum 4" stone base compacted, 6"x 6" #10 wire mesh, 4" concrete. Fiber mesh may also be utilized.

Asphalt Driveway/Apron: Minimum 6" stone base compacted, stone base to be rolled with minimum 2-ton roller. Apply hot mix surface coarse or 2" compacted 1-11 or equivalent.

Paver Driveway/Apron: Minimum 6" stone base compacted with bedding sand. Edging installed to prevent shifting.

Inspections Required: Pre-pour/Base (for concrete, new driveways, or any dimension changes) & Final Inspection.
